

Compliance to the resolutions taken in the IQAC meetings (Academic year: 2018-2019)

Resolution 1 (Meeting dated 07.03.2019): IQAC endorses the workshop of Chemistry Department on "E-content Development". There is no objection from any quarter regarding group effort of IQAC & Chemistry Department for successful accomplishment of the seminar.
